Subject:- Grant of Yearly Permission to Mahaveer College of Ayurvedic Science, Vill-Sundra, G.E. Road, Rajnandgaon-491441, Chhattisgarh (Inst. ID-AYU0468) with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 1st Renewal of 16 seats in 04 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Prasuti & Stri Roga - 04 seats, (ii) Shalya Tantra- 04 seats, (iii) Kaumarbhritya - 04 seats, (iv) Rog Nidan avum Vikrit Vigyan - 04 seats for the academic session 2025-26 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 reg.

Sir/Madam,

- To assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **Mahaveer College of Ayurvedic Science, Vill-Sundra, G.E. Road, Rajnandgaon-491441, Chhattisgarh (Inst. ID-AYU0468)** inspection was conducted on **20.03.2025 and 21.03.2025 on Hybrid mode** as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process the **Yearly Permission with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 1st Renewal of 16 seats in 04 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Prasuti & Stri Roga - 04 seats, (ii) Shalya Tantra- 04 seats, (iii) Kaumarbhritya - 04 seats, (iv) Rog Nidan avum Vikrit Vigyan - 04 seats for the academic session 2025-26 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.**
- The visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulations namely the Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals Regulations, 2024", provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations thereunder. **On careful examination of the assessment report following shortcomings/defects have been observed:-**

1. Teaching staffs:-

- Availability** of total teaching staff for UG (BAMS) Course as per the part-1 submitted by the college is $\frac{\text{Available}}{\text{Required}} \times 100\% = \frac{29}{30} \times 100\% = 96.67\%$ **(Excluding Excess)**

- Availability** of hospital staff is $\frac{\text{Available}}{\text{Required}} \times 100\% = \frac{78}{84} \times 100\% = 92.86\%$.

2. Animal house is not available. MOU is not attached.

- 3) The assessment report was duly placed before the 126th Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) convened on 13.06.2025 and Board concluded that the college do not meet the notified & requisite approved criteria for issuance of permission as per the Concerned Acts and regulations but is fulfilling the criteria in accordance with the Board's policy letter issued on 09.01.2025 & 20.01.2025. Further the Board also observed that the college is not fulfilling the criteria for extended permission for UG in accordance with regulation 54(2) of MESAR UG Ayurveda regulations 2024, as a monetary penalty was imposed on the college as per section 28(1)(f) of NCISM Act, 2020, for the academic year 2022-23 and not fulfilling for extended permission in PG courses as the college was issued the letter of permission to start 04 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Prasuti & Stri Roga - 04 seats, (ii) Shalya Tantra- 04 seats, (iii) Kaumarbhritya - 04 seats, (iv) Rog Nidan avum Vikrit Vigyan - 04 seats in academic year 2024-25. Accordingly, the Board decided as follows:

- a) To issue yearly permission in UG(BAMS) course with 60 seats in accordance with Regulation 54 (3) of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges 2024 as per the provision under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020, for the academic session 2025-26.
- b) To issue for 1st Renewal of permission in PG with intake capacity of 16 seats in 04 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Prasuti & Stri Roga- 04 seats, (ii) Shalya Tantra- 04 seats, (iii) Kaumarbhritya- 04 seats, (iv) Rog Nidan avum Vikrit Vigyan- 04 seats in accordance with Regulation 45(3) of NCISM (Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Ayurveda) Regulations 2024, as per the provision under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020, for the academic session 2025-26.

"DECISION"

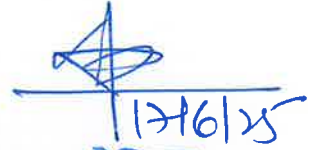
- 4) Therefore Mahaveer College of Ayurvedic Science, Vill-Sundra, G.E. Road, Rajnandgaon-491441, Chhattisgarh (Inst. ID-AYU0468) is hereby granted with:-
- a) Yearly permission in UG (BAMS) course with intake capacity of 60 seats for the academic session 2025-26 in accordance with Regulation 54 (3) of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges 2024 and;
- b) 1st Renewal of permission in PG with intake capacity of 16 seats in 04 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Prasuti & Stri Roga- 04 seats, (ii) Shalya Tantra- 04 seats, (iii) Kaumarbhritya- 04 seats, (iv) Rog Nidan avum Vikrit Vigyan- 04 seats for the academic session 2025-26 in accordance with Regulation 45(3) of NCISM (Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Ayurveda) Regulation, 2024;
- 5) The aforementioned decision is issued under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 subject to the condition that following requirements shall be fulfilled:-
- I. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 60 seats in UG and minimum 15% of postgraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 16 seats in 04 PG courses shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2025-26 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
- II. It is also informed that determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref no. BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/Regulatory Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.
- 6) Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
- 7) Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such

University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020** the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.

- 8) Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- 9) **The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college as per Regulation 55 (2) of MESAR 2024 and the compliance report shall be submitted before 31st December, 2025 to be considered for the permission for the academic session 2026-2027:-**
- All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled.
 - All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
 - All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Ayurveda) Regulations, 2024.
 - All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.
 - The shortcoming mentioned in Para no. 2 above, shall be fulfilled.
- 10) The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college within the timeline as mentioned above to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2026-27.
